WEIGH-IN AND GROOMING CHECK – OFFICIALS WILL BE PRESENT AT ALL WEIGH-INS

Weigh-ins will not be held at Fountain Valley HS. Weigh-ins will be held both Friday and Saturday in the Banquet Room, at the Hotel Huntington Beach, 7667 Center Ave., Huntington Beach, 92647. See attached sheet for further information on the Hotel Huntington Beach. Each coach is expected to be present to identify his wrestlers during weigh-in in order to prevent misunderstandings and/or mistakes. Grooming will be checked prior to weigh-in. **All wrestlers must be present in the weigh-in area at the beginning of weigh-ins.** All weigh-ins will begin with the 103 lb. class and proceed in order up to the 275 lb. class. When all wrestlers for a weight class have had an opportunity to weigh-in and the next class is called, that weight class is closed.

PAIRINGS

Pairings for the Masters Meet will be according to a formula available after each divisional championship match. The meet will be a 32-student bracket, with 30 wrestlers, double elimination tournament. Byes for the first round will be determined by a random draw. Please do not call the CIF-SS office for the draw, it will be available Friday at the Masters Meet.

ENTRY

There will be no entry fee charged for the Masters Meet. An eligibility list for all participants should be on file with the CIF-SS office.

COACHES

During the tournament competition, a maximum of two team coaches will be permitted to sit in the restricted area. Facilities permitting, coaches shall be seated at least ten feet from the official's table and the edge of the mat.

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to all champions.

ALTERNATES

There will be no alternates to the Masters Meet.

ADMISSION

The ticket booths will be open at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, February 25th, please let your spectators know. This is a CIF-SS sponsored event. Participants and coaches will be admitted free of charge (two coaches passes and one manager pass per school. However, if your school has but one wrestler, schools will be provided one coach's pass and one manager pass. All others will pay the regular admission price.

Locker rooms will be provided, but each wrestler must bring his own towel. Valuables should NOT be left in the lockers; teams should make arrangements for their protection.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Photographers who wish to be on the floor during the competition must secure permission by obtaining a Photo Pass from the Tournament Manager. There will be one picture taken of all champions at the conclusion of the meet for publication. Please have wrestlers stay in uniform.

The CIF State Wrestling Championships will be held at CENTENNIAL GARDEN, BAKERSFIELD, FRIDAY AND SATURDAY, MARCH 4 and 5, 2005.
